## **Roxburghe House**

Located on Ashgrove Road Aberdeen, Roxburghe House is a specialist palliative care unit managed by NHS Grampian where care concentrates on symptom control for patients with life limiting illness. The multi-disciplinary clinical team is committed to delivering care that ensures the best quality of life for the patient enabling them to live as full a life as possible within the constraints of their illness. The Unit also provides support to carers and families. Opportunities to Volunteer at Roxburghe House include:

# **Coffee Bar/ Tea Trolley**

Providing a service to patients and visitors at the coffee bar which offers complimentary tea and Coffee, with the addition of serving various priced items including cold drinks and snacks. Keeping the coffee bar area clean and tidy. There is an additional requirement to welcome and signpost patients & visitors to the Unit when the receptionist is not available. Other duties to assist the Inpatient Unit staff with provision of the afternoon tea round, providing a refreshment trolley service for hot and cold drinks for the patients. The coffee bar and tea trolley are covered Monday – Sunday with various shifts between 10.00 – 16.00 hours.

### **Volunteer Driver**

Volunteer drivers help support patients attending our Day Unit. Using your own vehicle and reimbursed with mileage costs, you would be providing a personal transport service for independently mobile patients attending Roxburghe. This requirement is for a Tuesday to Thursday, collecting patients from home and returning them after attending the Day Unit. A clean, current driving licence is required.

### Notes specific to Volunteering at Roxburghe House

- We gently suggest that volunteering at Roxburghe House may not be suitable for those that have suffered bereavement in the last 12-18 months.
- Unfortunately, we are unable to offer placements for those under 18 years of age.

# Chaplaincy Volunteer Visitors - Woodend Hospital, Royal Cornhill Hospital and Aberdeen Royal Infirmary

Hospital chaplains work with a large group of volunteers who assist in many different ways and the team of Volunteer Visitors are trained by the chaplains to visit patients in the wards.

### **Sunday Escorts for Woodend & Royal Cornhill Hospitals**

We are recruiting Chaplaincy Sunday Escorts to help with the services at Woodend and Royal Cornhill Hospitals. Escorts collect patients from the wards and bring them to the area where the services take place (usually in wheelchairs), sit with them during the half hour service, taking them back to the wards after the service.

We have a rota system so that each escort is committed to only one Sunday a month. The service at Woodend starts at 10.30am and is held in the Day Room of Stroke Rehabilitation (West). Escorts are asked to attend by 9.45am and are usually finished by 11.15am at the latest. The service at Royal Cornhill Hospital starts at 11am and is held in the waiting area of Block A. Escorts are asked to arrive between 10.15am and 10.30am and are usually finished by 11.45am.

This role provides a unique opportunity in Aberdeen Royal Infirmary to meet a wide variety of people; patients, visitors, carers, staff and transport providers. We require a commitment of 2-3 hours a week, with morning or afternoon shifts between 9.30 am and 3.30 pm working in teams. The service is currently based at concourse & rotunda entrances ARI with plans to extend this across the Foresterhill site.

A mature and friendly nature is required in this role, volunteers should demonstrate an interest in others, confidence in approaching people to offer assistance and be comfortable with chatting with visitors helping put them at ease.

Team members must have a good level of fitness as you will be 'on your feet' for most of the shift and you need to accompany visitors to their destination. If you have any questions around this, please contact the Volunteer Coordinator.

This is a very busy role working without direct supervision across the hospital and you must be able to remain calm in challenging situations, be able to take direction and seek guidance when necessary.

### Notes specific to this opportunity

- A good level of spoken and in reading English is essential for this role.
- Unfortunately we are currently unable to offer placements for those under 18 years of age in this role.
- Due to the training involved this role requires a minimum 12 months commitment.
- Whilst training applicants may be required to work a number of different shifts to complete their induction before being placed onto a regular morning or afternoon shift Monday to Friday.
